

International Student Admission Checklist

Please review the information for International Applicants on the website of the campus you want to attend for details on what's required to apply. (You can find links to all campus websites at calstate.edu/apply/international; select a campus in the "Choosing a Campus" section.)

When you're ready to complete your application to the CSU, be sure you have these items on hand:

- Transcripts/academic records** You will be asked to identify the institutions you attended and to provide dates and any certificates/diplomas or academic credentials earned. You will be required to enter your coursework only for U.S. high school and/or college coursework. (English translations of all academic records and certificates/diplomas will be required if the original language of the document is not English.)
- English-language exam results** Tests scores may not be required at the time of application, but do provide these scores if they are available. Please include results from the TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language), IELTS (International English Language Testing System), Pearson Test of English, EIKEN Test in Practical English Proficiency, and/or ALI (American Language Institute) exams.
- Test scores** If you're currently studying in the U.S., you will report any applicable test results completed so far for the SAT, ACT, AP and/or IB as well as any future test dates.
- A method of payment** You can pay the application fee by credit card or PayPal.
